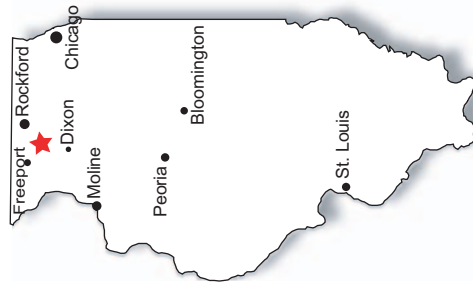

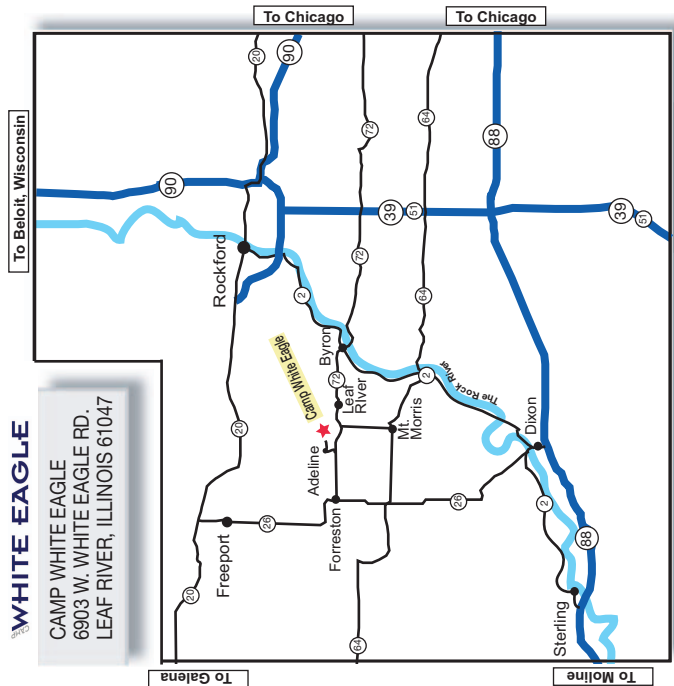

Camp White Eagle is located just west of Leaf River, Illinois. Our 126 acre site is heavily wooded, bisected by the Leaf River and is home to wild flowers, deer, wild turkey, and other abundant wild life. It is an ideal place for both fun and quiet contemplation.

Camp White Eagle focuses on the development of individuals and groups. Our name reflects the long history of our site as a place ideal for individual and group development. CWE began as a residential camp site for 4-H in 1950. 4-H continues to utilize the site as one of the many public and private groups we serve.

Staff

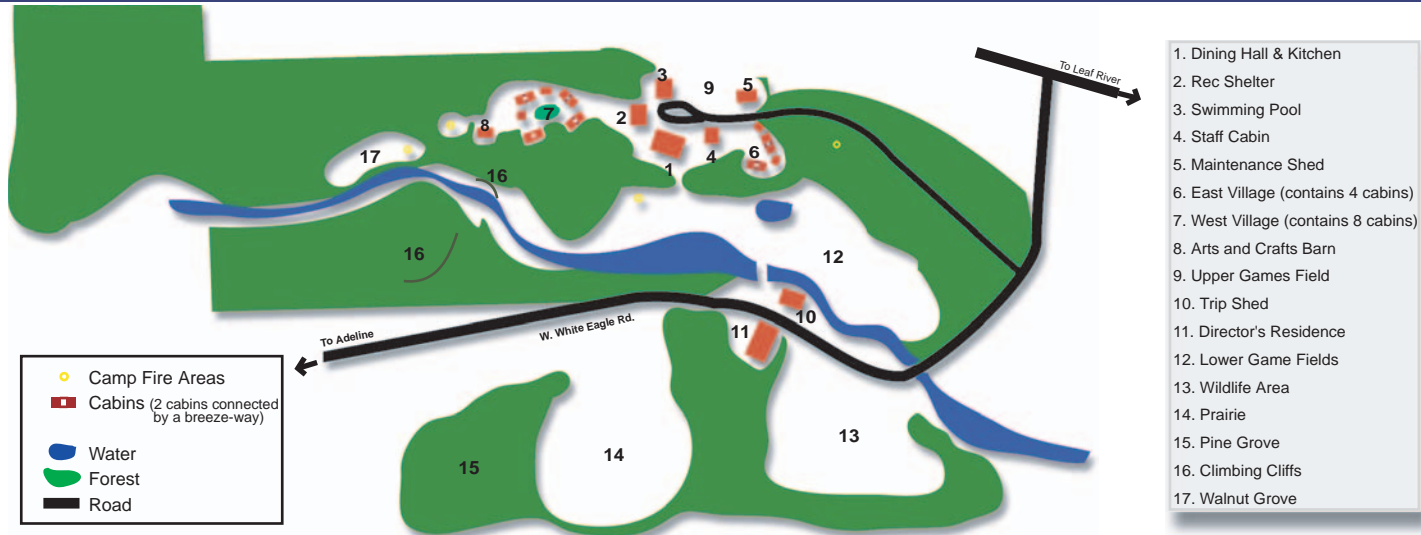
Summer Staff: During the peak summer season (June through August), CWE provides groups with up to 10 full time program staff and a variety of support staff (kitchen, maintenance, administrative). All of the Program staff are certified in:

Main Buildings & Areas

The **Main Lodge** is our:

- dining area
- conference/ meeting/ training area
- food service area
- administrative office
- and central social area.



This year-round building, with a 40 by 80 foot main room, stone fireplace, and bluff location, gives an atmosphere that enhances almost any activity. It accommodates up to 175 people comfortably.



Our beautiful 30 by 60 fully staffed **Swimming Pool** is located in the heart of camp and available to most summer groups. The pool area is tightly controlled with a fenced enclosure, locked gates and controlled access to even the attached shower area.



Lake & River

The Leaf River runs through the middle of CWE and allows for river walks, fishing, and great nature exploration. A seasonal dam creates a 5 acre lake for canoeing, swimming, water games and for almost a mile of canoeing through the property. A waterfall created by the dam is another great summer cooling experience!



Housing Options

1. 12 cabins (housing up to 144 people) arranged in an **East Village** (4 cabins and wash house) and a **West Village** (8 cabins and 2 wash houses). The cabins are wood framed, have concrete floors, windows and six bunk beds.
2. The Trip Shed houses 12 to 18 people in three rooms and has two bathrooms.
3. The Staff Cabin houses 12 people in two rooms and has two bathrooms.
4. The Visitors Cabin houses 8 people and has 2 bathrooms.
5. Sleeping mats in the Main lodge accommodate up to 60.



Four standard cabins, the staff cabin, and the visitors cabin are winterized



Rec Shelter:

The rec shelter is a screened in building which allows for activities to resume outside free of bugs and rain. There is a stage and 9 picnic tables which can be used or removed depending on the activity. It will accommodate up to 200 people comfortably.

Food Service

Food Service options are available throughout the year. Varied menus are available to suit your group's needs.
